As I've grown in my professional journey I've continued to benefit from the diversity of my peers, industry leaders, and the connections I've made across all partners in the ophthalmic space. Since making the leap to industry, Steven Zhang, MD, PhD, an OWL Member, whom I met in my first role at Shire, has been pivotal to my growth and continues to not only be a mentor, but someone I bounce ideas off and collaborate with even though we no longer work together. I believe these types of connections are exactly the experiences that align with OWL and why it means so much to me.


